

The annual tribute is our way of honoring, celebrating and acknowledging the accomplishments and contributions of Irish Americans, statewide.

The list this year with its newcomers and veterans alike demonstrates a commitment of those on it to their Irish American heritage and, just as importantly, to their communities, as well.

Last year we saluted the 85-year-old Irish pub, McGovern's Tavern, located on New Street in downtown Newark.

We did so in anticipation of the Newark Irish Parade, which, because of the pandemic, was cancelled, a rare occurrence since 1936 except for perhaps the World War II years and a major snowstorm.

This year, we'll again be missing the marching bands, the skirling of the pipes and if you are a parade fan, the biting March wind as we remain in the shadow of Covid-19.

He served as Chairman/ Board of Trustees and Chairman/ Board of Regents at Saint Peter's College. He also served as Chairman/Garden State Cancer Center and Chairman/Jersey City and Hudson County Democratic Committees.

In addition, he received appointments to various state boards and commissions from Governors Hughes, Cahill, Byrne, Kean and Florio. While serving as Hudson County Executive, he guided the county when it most needed his steady hand.

He was largely responsible for bringing Liberty State Park from dream to reality. His efforts secured the necessary state funding to clean and open the southern tip of the Park in time for the nation's bicentennial on July 4, 1976.



Harry A. McEnroe (1931-2021)

Former Essex County legislator (8-term NJ Assemblyman), native of Vailsburg, Newark and long time resident of South Orange where he chaired the Democratic Committee for many years. Harry and his wife Peggy are parents of seven children and grandparents of twelve.

A U.S. Army veteran, and former Essex County Freeholder, Harry was known for the development of NJ's solid waste recycling program through the McEnroe Act and for legislation creating the NJ Poison Control Center.



Jack McGarry, Jr. (1951-2021)

Retired East Orange PD Detective Sergeant, veteran of the Essex County Prosecutor's Office and Homeland Security and acclaimed piper with the Essex County Emerald Society Police & Fire Pipe Band.

A U.S. Army Reserve veteran, Jack was a former Grand Marshal of the West Orange St. Patrick's Day Parade. "He was a passionate and memorable man who left his mark on all who crossed his path."



Thomas J. Tevlin (1936–2021)

Thomas (Tommy T.) Tevlin of Caldwell and Lavallette was a career civil servant and Irish American activist. Raised in Newark, he was the proud son of John (County Meath) and Nora (nee Cox) of County Roscommon. A veteran of the United States Navy (corpsman), Tom had the great fortune to meet (the love of his life), Carolyn Vaughan, at a dance at McGovern's Tavern. They married in 1959 and spent 60 loving years together.

Long-time President of FMBA Local 25 in Maplewood, Tom was an active member in the following Irish associations; Cryan's, Giblin's and The Irish American Society of the Oranges. He served as an officer in the Emerald Society of Essex County and the Friendly Sons of the Shillelagh of West Orange. Tom was 2011 Grand Marshal of the West Orange Irish Parade.



John K. (Jack) Rafferty (1939-2021)

Trenton born and a proud graduate of Trenton Catholic High School, Jack, a U.S. Navy veteran served his country in the United States Navy (1957-1959). He went on to Trenton Junior College, LaSalle University, and the University of Kentucky Law School.

Jack was elected to the Hamilton Township committee in 1974 serving as the sole Republican committeeman. He won election as Mayor on his first attempt and retired undefeated in 2000, a record never challenged in the last twenty years. He served briefly in the State Assembly for two years, but his true love was being Mayor.

He had some of the highest vote totals in Hamilton Township history. Jack was selected by the State GOP to co-chair President Reagan's Presidential campaign in 1980.



Rev. Msgr. James J. Finnerty (1929-2021)

Msgr. James (Fr. Jim) Finnerty passed away peacefully this month while a resident of Peace Care St. Ann's in Jersey City. He attended Seton Hall Prep and the University as well as Immaculate Conception Seminary where he served as an instructor and Dean.

"Msgr. Finnerty was a priest in the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Newark for 66 years. He spent time in a variety of ministries: inner-city, seminary administration, counseling, hospital work, as a chaplain and pastoring parishes."

Monsignor started his career in 1955 as parochial vicar of Sacred Heart parish in Newark's Vailsburg section, the largest parish church in the Archdiocese at the time with thousands of parishioners. "Father Jim also served at St. Andrew's in Bayonne, St. Mary's in Jersey City, St. Leo in Irvington, St. Charles Borromeo and St. John in Newark (parish and soup kitchen) and Immaculate Conception in Montclair. At three of the stops, he was pastor."

Seton Hall Prep grad and University of Richmond freshman. Posthumously named 2015 Young Irishman by the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick of the Oranges.
